ON 12/14/2010, I WAS DISPATCHED TO 8500 OLD MADISON PIKE FOR A REPORT OF A FIGHT THAT WAS OCCURRING. UPON ARRIVAL, I OBSERVED THE VICTIM, MARK FAIRBANKS, STANDING OUTSIDE HIS TAXI CAB. A FEMALE, LATER IDENTIFIED AS LYNNE CHAFIN, WAS SITTING IN THE BACK SEAT. AS I APPROACHED, I HEARD MR. FAIRBANKS SHOUTING AT MS. CHAFIN TO EXIT THE VEHICLE. MS. CHAFIN WOULD NOT EXIT THE VEHICLE AND WAS SEEN YELLING OBSCENITIES TO MR. FAIRBANKS. AT NO TIME DID I WITNESS MS. CHAFIN KICK OR OTHERWISE TOUCH MR. FAIRBANKS. THE TWO WERE SEPERATED, AT WHICH TIME, MR. FAIRBANKS STATED THAT HE WAS TAKING MS. CHAFIN HOME WHEN SHE SUDDENLY BECAME UPSET AND BEGAN KICKING THE INSIDE OF HIS VEHICLE. AT SOME PONIT, MS. CHAFIN KICKED THE BACK OF MR. FAIRBANKS HEAD AS HE WAS DRIVING THROUGH THE CITY OF MADISON. MR. FAIRBANKS STOPPED THE VEHICLE AT THE ABOVE LOCATION. WHILE THERE, MS. CHAFIN CONTINUED TO KICK MR. FAIRBANKS AS HE TRIED TO FORCE HER FROM HIS VEHICLE. MR. FAIRBANKS WAS UNABLE TO SAY HOW MANY TIMES SHE HAD KICKED HIM WITH HER FEET. MS. CHAFIN

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WAS EXTREMELY INTOXICATED AND HAD TROUBLE STANDING ON HER OWN. I ALSO SMELLED A STRONG ODOR OF AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE EMITTING FROM HER PERSON. DUE TO HER INTOXICATED STATE, MS. CHAFIN WAS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY AND CHARGED WITH PUBLIC DRUNKNESS. MR. FAIRBANKS SUFFERED FROM NO INJURIES AND REFUSED MEDICAL TREATMENT. IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT MR. FAIRBANKS NEVER RECEIVED PAYMENT FROM MS. CHAFIN FOR THE CAB RIDE. THE CAB FARE WAS VERIFIED AND WAS BROUGHT TO MS. CHAFIN'S ATTENTION. IT WAS AT THIS TIME, SHE AGREED TO PAY THE \$25.00 CAB FARE. I ADVISED MR. FAIRBANKS OF THE WARRANT PROCEDURES, AT WHICH TIME, HE STATED THAT HE WILL BE PURSUING CRIMINAL CHARGES.
